

MYSTICAL MOLAS - INTRO TO MOLA MAKING

SKILL LEVEL: ALL LEVELS (MUST HAVE BASIC HAND APPLIQUE SKILLS)

CLASS SIZE: 16 STUDENTS

DURATION: 2 DAYS / 12 HOURS (SEE NOTE BELOW)

MOLAs have been created by the Kuna Indians of Panama ever since they were introduced to fabrics. Colorful and intricate MOLAs attract attention! Combining vibrant colors and appliqué skills most of us have acquired in the past make this an easy technique to learn. Design and create your very own small MOLA in the colors you desire.

Supply List for “Mystical Molas”:

- Thimble
- Small, sharp embroidery scissors
- Pen and note paper
- Pad of unlined paper
- Small selection of pencil crayons

Instructor will provide:

- Complete Kit provided by the instructor at \$ 20.00/person.
(Kit includes all fabrics, threads, needle as well as a complete book with step-by -step instructions with color photographs)

Organizer needs to provide:

- Tables and chairs for participants
- 2 irons and ironing boards
- White board or flip chart with markers

Please note: This workshop may be offered as a one-day class. This means that the design element of the workshop will not be presented. Everyone will be creating the same small sample to learn the technique. As time allows, participants will begin on the needle case.
